

## One of the best nutcakes of Switzerland! Now available for PolioPlus

The “Tuorta da Nusch”, a traditional Engadine nut cake from the family confectionery Giacometti in Lavin, is known for its excellent quality, for 4 generations! The proceeds will go to Rotary's PolioPlus programme. With every cake sold, 60 children can be vaccinated / protected from lifelong polio (CHF30 per cake will go towards PolioPlus, also thanks to the Bill & Melinda Gates 2-1 Challenge Grant). This makes this cake all the more delicious.

### *What else do I need to know?*

There are 3 delivery units. Boxes of 3, 8 or 17 cakes, each packed in an attractive box (see photo below). The price, free of delivery charge, is CHF 19, 18, and 17 per cake, according to the units mentioned above. Each cake weighs 450 g and has a shelf life of 3 months. Orders are accepted from now until Easter.
